## THE NEW SILICA STANDARD

### What you need to know.

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) has issued a final rule to curb lung cancer, silicosis, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and kidney disease in America's workers by limiting their exposure to respirable crystalline silica. The final rule on Occupational Exposure to Crystalline Silica in Construction, published on March 25, 2016, established a new Permissible Exposure Limit and contained several other ancillary provisions that apply to the construction industry. Enforcement of the standards will begin September 23, 2017. This course is designed to discuss employer's responsibilities regarding exposure to silica and compliance with the new standard, including the requirements of a silica program, silica sampling methods, medical surveillance programs, and silica
